Perrysburg Campus

- **7:30-8:15 a.m. Child care drop off and 3:15 – 5:30 p.m. pick up**
 - All campers who need early morning care and after care, please enter through the office doors and sing in or out. Child care will be held in the Great Room each day.
- **8:15-8:30 a.m. Drop Off**
 - Families are welcome to park in front of the school in the marked parking spaces to drop off their campers. A couple camp teacher will greet you and help receive your child each morning. If you're planning to walk your camper to the classroom doors, please park in the parking lot and walk up. Parents, please refrain from entering the classroom daily.
- **11:30-11:45 a.m. and 3:00-3:15 p.m. Pick Up**
 - Families are welcome to park in front of the school in the marked spaces and wait for their campers to come out for pick up. A teacher will walk your child to the car (similar to the school year). Please do not leave your car unattended in car line. You're welcome to park in the parking lot and walk up to receive your child as well. If a new person picking up your camper please send a note with your child and we will check identification before dismissing your camper.

Toledo Campus

- **7:30-8:15 a.m. Child care drop off and 3:15 – 5:30 p.m. pick up**
 - All students who need early morning care and after care, please enter directly through the Main Lobby (park in the large lot on the west side of the property).
- **8:15-8:30 a.m. Drop Off**
 - All campers arriving during morning drop off should be walked to the front doors at the East entrance where a greeter will be there holding the doors open. All campers must be walked to the doors (parents are welcome to walk to the classrooms but please refrain from entering the rooms). Promptly at 8:30 a.m. the door will be closed. Any late arrivals will enter through the Main Lobby.
- **11:30-11:45 a.m. and 3:00-3:15 p.m. Pick Up**
 - Families are welcome to park in any marked parking spaces near the sidewalk or park in the small parking lot on the East side of the property. We will not walk children down to your vehicle during summer camp. When you walk up to the East building to receive your camper, please wait outside the Nest/patio area. A teacher will dismiss your child each day. This will help keep all the children safe and going home with the correct caregiver. If a new person is picking up your camper, please send a note with your child and we will check identification before dismissing your camper.
